



## Vivaldi Construction Environmental Policy

At Vivaldi Construction we believe in doing our small part to help the environment so we've developed a sustainability policy with Environmental Scientists from the University of Nottingham that meets UK government environmental guidelines.

1. We adhere to the "Control of Pollution (Amendment) Act of 1989" which ensures the proper disposal and transport of waste through regulations on the following issues:
  - 1.1 Transporting controlled waste without registering
  - 1.2 Registration of carriers
  - 1.3 Seizure and disposal of vehicles used for illegal waste disposal
  
2. We comply with "The Waste (England and Wales) Regulations 2011" requiring businesses to administer the waste management hierarchy which sets out the waste management options a company should consider, in order of priority:
  - 2.1 Prevention
  - 2.2 Preparation for re-use
  - 2.3 Recycling
  - 2.4 Recovery - e.g. energy recovery
  - 2.5 Disposal
  
3. Our construction process on-site will always seek to ensure the reduction of any unnecessary waste and a consideration of environmental impacts for all activities involved.
  
4. We also implement low-level, individual approaches to environmental sustainability through the recycling of office waste, use of energy saving lighting and energy efficient heating and electrical appliances. We also implement a "Walk to Work" scheme encouraging our employees to travel to work on foot, where possible, to reduce the environmental impacts from vehicle pollution.
